This training is recommended to all employees, including IT staff, managers, HR, accounting, DPOs and other departments.

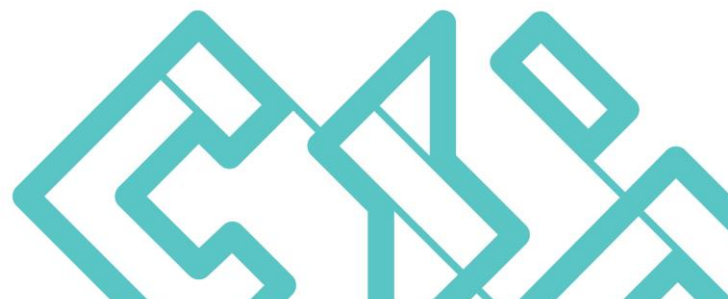
After training all participants are issued certificates, confirming the completion of training.
